- **IP Enabled System Unified Capabilities Conference System.** The DOD has called for the enterprise wide implementation of Unified Capabilities to be fielded to DOD components by fiscal 2016. UC includes a broad set of IP-enabled capabilities that enable unprecedented joint collaboration among the military services and defense agencies.
- **Voice Network Connectivity** via AS-SIP with TLS and SRTP encryption via the ASLAN directly to LSC's, SC, or SS listed on the APL, or via T1 Primary Rate Interface (PRI).
- **WebView**, the new **Web Services based browser interface** for system administration and user access via a site enabled PKI workstation or PC; requires no plug-ins.
- **Advanced Scheduling Capabilities** via WebView browser for conference scheduling and notification.
- **Multiple PreSet Conference Options** connect all participants quickly and efficiently (initiated at conference scheduled start, by first caller or host arrival, by chairperson on demand, and via browser window or touchtone codes).
- **Large reference base** of successful DOD server installations completed.
- **Information Assurance Compliance** - SCAP Compliance Scan Score over 96%; Forum turnkey installation includes scan and mitigation assistance.
- **Scalable to 2000 Sessions** (1920 PRI Ports) in a 4U Chassis.
